FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear El Sistema USA® Members and Partners.

In 2024, El Sistema USA conducted our bi-annual census to gather data from the 2023-2024 school year. The census was distributed to 142 member programs, with 84 responses—a strong 60% response rate. Data collection ran from October 2024 to May 2025, with analysis provided by Ward Analytics.

The findings tell an encouraging story: the El Sistema USA network continues to grow in both depth and breadth. From 2022 to 2024, the number of students served increased by 26%, with our membership now reaching more than 30,000 young people!

This year's census also reflects our new Guiding Pillars—High Quality Music Education, Equity and Access, and Holistic Impact—alive and thriving across our network:

- High Quality: Programs provide an average of 7 hours of weekly instruction, demonstrating the intensive, high-dosage model that defines El Sistema USA.
- Equity and Access: Members continue to break down barriers to participation, offering free tuition and instruments, transportation, tutoring, meals, and more.
- Holistic Impact: Two-thirds of programs offer paid internships and hire alumni, creating intentional pathways for student leadership and career opportunities in music and beyond.

The data also highlights areas for growth. While 68% of respondents offer summer programming, most opportunities are limited to 1–3 weeks and part-day schedules—leaving a significant gap during a critical time for student engagement and musical progress.

Census findings also reveal that programs are often navigating uneven arts ecosystems: some serve as the only provider of music education in their partner schools, while others supplement or enhance existing school-based instruction.

Encouragingly, programs are showing strong staff retention—20% of staff have been with their programs for six or more years—and 60% of organizations employ in-school music teachers, signaling regular collaboration and connection with public school systems.

We are deeply grateful to every member program that contributed to this year's census. Together, this data tells a powerful story of our collective impact: a national coalition of music programs using music as a vehicle for opportunity, personal development, and community.




Approximately half of the ESUSA member organizations are an independent 501(c)(3).





Students Served by Grade (n=77)



(n=77)












Average Number of Hours Per Week by Grade (n=77)






Classes Offered

El Sistema USA programs offer a wide variety of classes, instruments, and genres, from Song Writing to Wind Ensemble. The most common classes offered are String Ensemble, Instrumental Sectionals, Orchestra, and Individual Lessons. Many programs offer non musical classes such as academic support and leadership classes.


2023-2024 School Year Classes, Excluding Summer Offerings, n=82





Additional Services Offered


ESUSA programs offer much more than just music. Most programs offer snacks and about one-third offer transportation and meals. This aligns with the El Sistema USA pillars of Equity and Holistic Impact

67% of respondents provide paid internships to students and 33% provide workforce development programs.



ESUSA Alumni



67% of respondents employ alumni. This reflects the growing number of students graduating out of El Sistema USA programs and going into music related careers.

71% of programs

surveyed do not charge annual tuition or fees for their programming.

29% of Programs

The range of tuition/fees was from \$20 to \$6,000. The mode is \$20, the median is \$263 and the average/mean is \$890.



Summer Programming

68% of respondents offer summer programming for students.



Only 54 programs responded to this question and this number represents a small percentage of the overall programs in the ESUSA membership.

> Despite being an important part of continued learning and engagement, many programs are not able to offer summer programming.








Percent of Organizations that Offered Programming in Summer 2024

Similar to annual program tuition, summer tuition prices and models vary greatly.

The range of tuition/fees was from \$10 to \$1500. The mode is \$25, the median is \$100 and the average/mean is \$266.

Hours and Weeks of Summer Programming

(n = 51)

Approximately 20% of programs provided 4 hours of programming per day and approximately 16% provided 6 hours of programming per day.

> The majority of programs ran summer programming either 4 or 5 days a week. Most programs ran 1-3 weeks of summer programming.

The first chart shows staffing averages based on different categories of staff members. It shows that most organizations rely on part time staff, contractors, and volunteer labor with fewer full time staff.

Average Number of Staff Members (n=74)









Teaching Staff (n=73)



Race and Ethnicity of Staff





Almost half of the teaching staff has been employed for 1-2 years.




Full Time In-School Music Teachers (n=71)

59% of programs of programs did employ full-time, in-school music teachers.

The range for organizations that do have teachers that are full-time, in-school music teachers is 1 teacher to 16 teachers. The average is 4 teachers.

Access to Music Education Outside El Sistema Programs, n=73

The pie chart shows respondent's answers to the music education access in the schools they work in. The data shows that El Sistema USA programs work within an uneven landscape of music education. Most ESUSA programs work in schools that do offer some music during the school day, but the reach is inconsistent. Some programs fill a gap in arts access and some serve as a supplement to existing music programming during the school day.


