Criteria for Membership

Social Change

- Central to the mission of the program is a demonstrated commitment to music as a vehicle for social impact.
- Program has key individual or institutional partners that provide expertise in both music and community/youth/social development.

Intensity

 In order to provide all children with intensive opportunities to practice and excel, students have access to at least 5 hours of musical instruction per week.

Access

- Primarily serve children with financial access barriers to other high-quality music programs.
- Provide programs in a manner that ensures equal access to all children regardless of ability to pay.



Ensemble

■ Emphasize ensemble programming as a core element of curriculum.

Nucleo Environment

- Students gather in a central location that serves as the program's home and is a safe haven and emblem of music as a social impact agent in the community.
- Programs demonstrate unifying practices that encourage students and teachers to know and support each other and develop a unique culture characterized by student driven activities, and instructor mentorship where students feel loved and valued as a member of the nucleo community.

Excellence

- Programs are of high quality; defined in part by regular musical instruction and established practices for measurable outcomes in both musical growth and positive social impact.
- Central to the curriculum are practices which foster musical excellence at all stages of development.

Community

Proven parental involvement and community engagement practices.

Continuum

Programs serve children for a minimum of 3 years and aspire to serve them beyond childhood and into young adulthood.

National Symposium

El Sistema USA® is proud to announce that we will host the 2024 National Symposium in partnership with Butler University from June 13-15, 2024. Save the date, more information to come.

El Sistema USA's 2024 National Symposium is a multi-day conference which will provide professional development, resource sharing, networking, and youth leadership opportunities for ESUSA members as well as individuals and partner organizations working in the field of music for social impact and creative youth development. The symposium is scheduled for Summer 2024, at Butler University. The conference will be hosted in partnership with local arts organizations to highlight community partnerships, collective impact, and youth voice. ESUSA will continue to prioritize youth leadership through the Youth Ambassador Program, where students and alumni will be paid to plan and execute content for both adults and students at the symposium. The event will be made possible in part by a \$20,000 grant from the National Endowment for the Arts.

Youth Ambassador Program

Each year El Sistema USA® selects 10+ high school youth ambassadors to prepare and present content at the National Symposium. Learn more about last year's 2023 Youth Ambassador Cohort here. Regional Seminarios & Gatherings

Each year, we support and encourage the gathering of students, teaching artists, and leaders regionally at regional seminarios and events. These are one-to-three-day events intended to bring students and/or staff from El Sistema USA Member Organizations together to network, learn, and make music, friends, and memories.

El Sistema USA Virtual Working Groups

In addition to our in-person gatherings, El Sistema USA hosts online virtual gatherings monthly from October to June for two Forums. Led by facilitators in the field, these are opportunities for leaders, administrators, and teaching artists to gather online to share resources, hear from external speakers, resource share, and network. The Teaching Artist Forum aims to provide a space for Teaching Artists working with El Sistema-inspired programs to collaborate, network, and workshop teaching ideas and strategies. Through six discussion-based forums facilitated in partnership with the Teaching Artists Training Institute (TATI), participants will explore best practices in music education by looking at case studies from peer Teaching Artists, address common classroom success and challenges, and idea swap tools for implementing new teaching techniques.

• Program Directors and Managers Forum | Facilitated by Gabrielle Molina

The Program Director & Manager Forum is an action-oriented, working group focused on sharing best programmatic tactics, strategies, and practices within the field. These sessions are aimed at Program Directors, Program Managers, Site Directors, but may be useful and applicable to other program decision makers and Teaching Artists.



As Program Directors & Managers, your position within an organization is unique in that you interface with many stakeholders within the program, whether that be students, families, teaching artists, and executive staff. Some of you may also deal with community partners, donors, and boards.

These sessions are intended to create a network of Program Directors and share out best practices collectively. Sessions will be a hybrid of some panel discussions and group discussions.

In addition to meeting bi-monthly, the resources generated from these groups will be available online for all members.

ESUSA Social Emotional Survey Tool

ESUSA is launching a new data initiative for the 2023-24 school year free of charge to members. ESUSA will provide a standardized student survey tool for programs to use which can be matched to measure change over time. We are developing an online portal with DART Analytics which will allow programs to upload their survey data and to view the results of their individual program. Types of Membership

1. Organizational Membership Options

Membership with El Sistema USA is an organizational membership that allows organizations to create an unlimited number of accounts for all staff, teaching artists, board members, volunteers, etc.

- Organizational Member: For established El Sistema-inspired organizations that meet the membership criteria (below).
- Member in Training: For El Sistema-inspired organizations in the first year of existence that meet or are working toward meeting the membership criteria.
- Affiliate Member: For organizations that align with the ESUSA <u>core values and vision</u>, but may not meet all of the membership criteria OR are not U.S/Canada based.

2. Individual Membership

El Sistema USA also offers an individual membership for those not associated with an organization that's already a member. Individual members receive the same benefits as our organization members.

Membership Dues

Membership Dues are due yearly at the anniversary of their inception date. All Members are welcome to enroll in payment plans to assist with payment.
